WW2 UK RAF folding machete (aircraft survival equipment), a copy of the USA design. Maker marked "Joseph Wesby 1944, this model with a "lanyard ring"



Post-WW2 USA machete (aircraft survival equipment), by CASE XX, NON folding type, manufacture "Case" call this their "V44"



WW2 USA folding survival Machete (aircraft survival equipment), used by: US Army air corps & US Navy air corps. manufacture: Cattaraugus USA (this was probably the 1st version). Naval model with non-captive shield). The RAF model was copied from this pattern. This example has the sheet metal blade shield which is often lost.
